Our network

IPAM is a collective composed of 6 international solidarity associations (Cedetim, Aec, Aitec, Cedidelp, Amorces, E&P) and around 50 individual activists, from historical member of the alterglobalisation movement to younger activists engaged in recent and spontaneous protests (gilets jaunes, against police brutality, #metoo...).

IPAM is a collective space of activism, non-partisan and non-ideological, where the diversity of points of view is respected, seeking unity of action when and if possible. IPAM is a space of political training transmission and emancipation, where analysis and activist practices are shared encouraging transmission from generation to generation. IPAM aims at sharing reflections and building bridges between networks within and around alterglobalist movements. In this framework, IPAM aims at :

- developing and sharing national and international solidarity strategy and practices able to answer today's challenges.
- linking local struggles in an international dimension
- encouraging exchanges between historical alterglobalist movements and self-organised resistance and solidarity movements
- articulate reflections, direct actions and advocacy

Intercoll: an open space for the development and confrontation of social and citizen movements.

IPAM is historically engaged in the social forums process. Cedetim, Aitec, Aec have been members of the International Council. IPAM is also a founding member of Attac and Crid, both committed in the WSF dynamic. To make the strategies of social movements visible between each forum, IPAM has developed an open space for the development and confrontation of social and citizen movements (Intercoll). It is run by people linked to the movements, everyone involved in the struggles and mobilizations. It deals with activists who engage in an intellectual work to renew, from the denunciations of injustices, interpretive frameworks and forms of engagement, at all levels, local, national, as global. The aim is to develop economic, social alternatives, and environmental policies to rethink the world in the paths of emancipation and solidarity. Intercoll will take part in several spaces of the virtual WSF, including coorganising the Science and Democracy Forum and the Palestine Forum.

“ The pandemic and climate crisis has reinforced this trend of authoritarian states taking control. It has upset situations and balances; it calls into question international solidarity, internationalism and alter-globalism. To a crisis that is by definition global, the responses have been mainly national and state-based. International institutions have been little listened to and have been marginalised. Movements have responded with local solidarity actions and resistance to their states. The contradictions have become more pronounced. In many countries, the confrontations oppose right-wing populist securitarian alliances to movements demanding democratic freedoms, the defence of social rights and ecological emergencies.
